Schleiermacher's project has not been understood very well. In this paper I am going to outline Schleiermacher's hermeneutic as it is found in his lecture notes, which were edited by Heinz Kimmerle and translated into English as *Hermeneutics: the Handwritten Manuscripts* (1977). All of my quotations will be from this book.

Friedrich Daniel Ernst Schleiermacher

Friedrich Daniel Ernst Schleiermacher. Almost every account of the history of modern hermeneutics pays some tribute to the founding role played by German Protestant theologian and philosopher Friedrich Daniel Ernst Schleiermacher (1768-1834).
